# ПРОГРАММА ВСТУПИТЕЛЬНОГО ЭКЗАМЕНА по английскому языку для поступающих в Лингвистический институт АлтГПУ

## Содержание вступительного экзамена

Экзамен по английскому языку проводится в форме письменного теста и состоит из четырёх частей.

**Часть 1 (Аудирование)** включает 15 заданий на проверку понимания прослушанного текста. Соискатели должны продемонстрировать умение понимать аутентичную речь, а также умение делать логические выводы на основании прослушанного. Данный блок включает следующие виды заданий:

- установление соответствия (1 задание) – тип В;
- выбор верного/неверного/ не названного в тексте варианта ответа (7 заданий) – тип А;
- выбор правильного ответа на основании прослушанного текста (7 заданий) – тип А.

Рекомендуемое время на выполнение части «Аудирование» - 25 минут.

**Часть 2 (Чтение)** включает 9 заданий на проверку понимания прочитанного текста. Соискатели должны продемонстрировать умения читать и понимать прочитанный текст, а также умение анализировать прочитанное, делать логические выводы и использовать лингвистическую догадку. Данный блок включает следующие виды заданий:

- установление соответствия (1 задание) – тип В;
- установление соответствия пропущенных блоков текста (1 задание) – тип В;
- выбор правильного ответа на основании прочитанного текста (7 заданий) – тип А.

Рекомендуемое время на выполнение части «Чтение» – 30 минут.

**Часть 3 (Лексика и грамматика)** включает 12 заданий, из которых 1 – на словообразование (10 вариантов – 10 баллов), 1 – на формобразование (10 вариантов – 10 баллов), и 10 заданий с выбором правильного ответа из четырёх предложенных. Данный блок заданий предполагает проверку лексико-грамматических навыков соискателей и их умения осуществлять необходимые словообразовательные трансформации.

Рекомендуемое время на выполнение части «Лексика и грамматика» – 40 минут.

Максимальное количество баллов за раздел – 30.

**Часть 4 (Письмо)** представляет собой письменную работу, состоящую из написания личного письма. Соискатели должны продемонстрировать лексические, грамматические и орфографические навыки оформления письменной речи, а также умение оформить личное письмо согласно существующим в английском языке нормам.

Рекомендуемое время на выполнение части «Письмо» – 25 минут. Максимальный балл за личное письмо 10 баллов (содержание, полнота выполнения задания – 4 балла, организация текста – 2 балла, языковое оформление (лексика, грамматика, орфография, пунктуация) – 4 балла).

## КРИТЕРИИ ОЦЕНИВАНИЯ

Каждое правильно выполненное задание в разделах «Аудирование», «Чтение», «Лексика и грамматика» оценивается в один балл.

Максимальный балл за личное письмо 10 баллов (содержание, полнота выполнения задания – 4 балла, организация сочинения, лексика и грамматика – 2 балла, орфография и пунктуация – 4 балла). Максимальный первичный балл за экзамен по английскому языку – 80 баллов. Итоговый балл определяется с учетом коэффициента уровня сложности задания. Для перевода в 100-балльную шкалу первичный балл умножается на соответствующий коэффициент. Максимальная сумма баллов, которую абитуриент может набрать по результатам вступительного экзамена, составляет 100 баллов, минимальная (пороговая) сумма баллов, которая позволяет оценить уровень подготовленности абитуриентов к освоению ООП составляет 40 баллов.

*Star Trek*, the story of a group of explorers on a voyage of discovery through space in the 23<sup>rd</sup> century, has become a multi-billion dollar industry with a cult following **1** \_\_\_\_ . Northways College now has full electronic information resources in the College Library to help you in your studies. On CD-ROM in the library we have about fifty databases, including many statistical sources. Want to know the average rainfall in Tokyo or the biggest export earner of Vanuatu? It's easy to find out. Whether you are in the School of Business or the School of Art & Design, it's all here for you.

You can conduct your own CD-ROM search for no charge, and you can print out your results on the library printers using your library photocopying card. Alternatively, you can download your results to disk, again for no charge, but bring your own formatted floppy disk or CD-ROM. If you are not sure how to conduct a search for yourself, library staff can do it for you, but we charge \$20 for this service, no matter how long or how short a time it takes.

All library workstations have broadband access to the Internet, so you can find the web-based information you need quickly and easily. If you are unfamiliar with using the Internet, help is available in several ways. You can start with the online tutorial *Netstart*; just click on the *Netstart* icon on the Main Menu. The tutorial will take you through the basic steps to using the Internet, at any time convenient to you. If you prefer, ask one of the librarians for internet advice (best at quiet times between 9.00 am and 11.30 am weekdays) or attend one of the introductory group sessions that are held in the first two weeks of each term. Sign your name on the list on the Library Bulletin Board to guarantee a place, as they are very popular.

A word of warning: demand for access to library workstations is very high, so you are strongly advised to book a workstation, and we have to limit your use to a maximum of one hour at any one time. Make your booking (for which you will receive a receipt) at the Information Desk or at the enquiry desks in the Media Services Area (Level I). Also, use of the computers is limited to Northways students only, so you may be asked to produce your Student identification Card to make a booking, or while using the workstations.
