Наименование испытания:
**«Современный иностранный язык
(английский язык)»**

Пояснительная записка

Вступительное испытание предполагает проверку знаний абитуриентов, имеющих среднее профессиональное образование, поступающих на дневную и заочную форму обучения по результатам испытаний, организуемых вузом. Экзамен проводится в письменной форме, и включает в себя тестовые задания с закрытыми и открытыми ответами.

Содержание вступительного экзамена

Экзамен проводится в форме письменного теста и состоит из трех частей.

Часть 1 (Чтение) включает задания на проверку понимания прочитанного текста. Соискатели должны продемонстрировать умения читать и понимать прочитанный текст, а также умение анализировать прочитанное, делать логические выводы и использовать лингвистическую догадку. Данный блок включает следующие виды заданий:

- установление соответствия (1 задание) – тип В;
- выбор правильного ответа на основании прочитанного текста (7 заданий) – тип А.

Рекомендуемое время на выполнение части «Чтение» – 20 минут.

Максимальное количество баллов – 40 баллов.

Часть 2 (Лексика и грамматика) включает 10 заданий, из которых 1 – на словообразование (5 вариантов – 20 баллов) и 5 заданий с выбором правильного ответа из четырёх предложенных. Данный блок заданий предполагает проверку лексико-грамматических навыков соискателей и их умения осуществлять необходимые словообразовательные трансформации.

Рекомендуемое время на выполнение части «Лексика и грамматика» – 20 минут.

Максимальное количество баллов за раздел – 40.

Часть 3 (Письмо) представляет собой письменную работу, состоящую из написания личного письма. Соискатели должны продемонстрировать лексические, грамматические и орфографические навыки оформления письменной речи, а также умение оформить личное письмо согласно существующим в английском языке нормам.

Рекомендуемое время на выполнение части «Письмо» – 20 минут.

Максимальный балл за личное письмо 20 баллов (содержание, полнота выполнения задания – 11 баллов, организация текста – 3 балла, языковое оформление (лексика, грамматика, орфография, пунктуация) – 6 баллов).

КРИТЕРИИ ОЦЕНИВАНИЯ

Каждое правильно выполненное задание в разделах «Чтение», «Лексика и грамматика» оценивается в 4 балла.

Максимальный балл за личное письмо 20 баллов.

Максимальный первичный балл за экзамен – 80 баллов. Максимальная сумма баллов, которую абитуриент может набрать по результатам вступительного экзамена, составляет 100 баллов, минимальная (пороговая) сумма баллов, которая позволяет оценить уровень подготовленности абитуриентов к освоению ООП составляет 40 баллов.
